Donald Lee Devin, 74, of Sardis City passed away on Wednesday, May 10th in the Year of Our Lord 2017.

The body will lie in state from 12 to 2 on May 17th at St. James Catholic Church in Gadsden.

Celebration of Life will be at St. James Catholic Church on Wednesday, May 17th beginning at 2pm. The service will be officiated by Father Jose B. Chacko with eulogy by Brother Chad Robertson.
