



Lee Wofford

May 5, 1928 - June 25, 2014

Services for former Etowah County Probate Judge and County Commissioner Lee Wofford will be Sunday, June 29, at 2 p.m. at Sardis Baptist Church, where he formerly served as deacon. The family will receive friends at the church beginning at 12:45. Wofford died June 25 at his home in Sardis City. He was 86. Wofford was born in the Smith Institute community of Etowah County in 1928, graduated Sardis High School in 1946, and served on the front lines in Korea. Wofford was elected to a record five consecutive terms from 1964 to 1980 as county commissioner and served as probate judge from 1984-1989. He was a 32nd degree Freemason. Wofford is survived by the former Frances Leeth, his wife of 63 years, 345 days; son Tom Wofford of Birmingham; grandson Russell (Haley) Wofford of Pell City; granddaughter Kylee Wofford of Los Angeles; sister Faye Kilpatrick of Gadsden; and 14 nieces and nephews. Wofford was predeceased by his elder son Terry Wofford and eldest grandchild, Patrick Wofford, by his parents G.A. "Ad" and Emma Wofford, sister Mildred Duke, and brothers Carl and D.C. Wofford. Wofford will be buried at Liberty Baptist Church Cemetery, where five generations of his family are buried. There will be no graveside service. The family thanks his Veterans Administration care team; including nurse Pam Rossen, Dr. Kendra Sheppard, Dr. Andrew Duxbury, and also hospice nurse Lindsay Martin.
