“ My brother Paul McDaniel is known by many throughout this area as someone who would come along side of anyone in need, whether it be a friend who has lost a loved one, or an older friend living out his last days alone.. He has even been a caregiver for a friend with cancer, doing nursing duties no matter how bad, and the friend beat the cancer. Paul was saved and baptized many years ago as a young man, and never failed to give of himself as Christ did. Paul said he read the Bible through several times while trying to kick the demons of alcohol and cigarettes. He finally did a few years ago. Then, a little over two years ago when he was diagnosed with cancer he fought hard to beat it. He never complained and insisted on staying home and working on his house, laying down two new wood floors and adding other renovations as he could. During this time, our sister Katie took him for his chemo and radiation treatments. Later, when all treatments were exhausted, Katie came out twice a day to bandage him. At night he listened to the late great Charles Stanley as the cancer continued worsening. Paul's friend and ours, Kathy, who lives in front of him, helped in many ways, especially toward the last few days he was home. About two weeks ago Paul called Katie and asked to stay with her and Randy (which he had been invited to do many times) because he could no longer stay upright. Hospice came almost daily after that and his Hospice nurse Esther brought her special brand of crazy comic personality into the sick room as well as thorough and expert care. Katie's husband Randy helped with lifting and changing linens, as he and my Mike did in our dad's last days when I could no longer lift him. When the cancer got really bad Esther insisted Katie not change him anymore and sent her to the other room while Esther did it. Toward the last few days Paul's friend Jimmy Hay came and read the Bible to Paul as did I. Paul's face, which was twisted with the pain and ravages of the disease, smoothed out before he died and he looked peaceful at the end. We know when Paul's spirit left his body that he was immediately present with his Lord and we will have a family reunion in the not too distant future.
