He is preceded in death by his father; Ben Tyler McBay and son; Phillip Dale McBay, Jr.

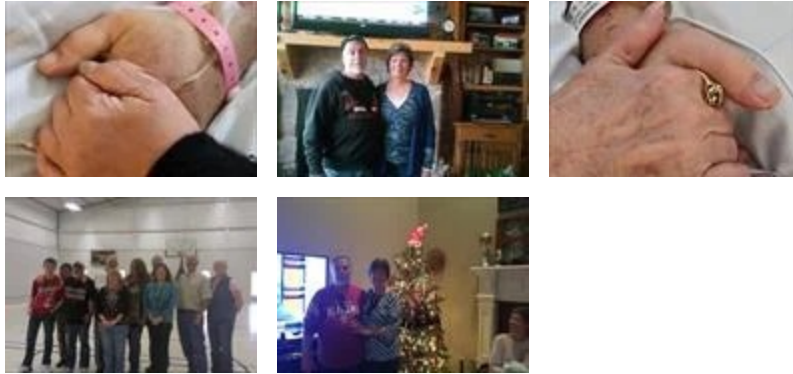
