Robert Allen Malone, 70, died at his residence in the Duck Springs community near Attalla, Alabama, on Friday, October 6, 2023. Robert was born on July 21, 1953, the son of Allen Jones Malone and Mary Gay McCarver Malone.

Robert was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Anita Mehurg Malone; his many aunts and uncles; first cousins, Lloyd Ray Malone, Jerry Ralph Malone, and Stephen Joseph McCaghren.

In the late 70's Robert, along with several high school friends, moved to Colorado to work in the copper mines. Upon returning to Duck Springs Robert became employed at Republic Steel, working primarily in the blast furnace. He worked at the steel plant until it ceased operation. Robert was last employed at Alexander Chevrolet in

Centre.

Robert and Anita married on Christmas day 1983. They lived throughout their marriage on his parents' farm in the Duck Springs community in the beautiful Big Wills Valley. Though never blessed with children, Robert and Anita were parents to many special pets over the years.

Robert was a big man with a big heart. After Anita's passing, Robert acquired a Pomeranian ball of fur he named Prissy. Robert had Prissy trained as a therapy dog and took her visiting at local nursing homes. Robert's constant companions up until his passing were another Pomeranian ball of fur named Rocky and Sylvie the cat.

Robert's nearest surviving relatives are his first cousins. When speaking with a cousin he typically ended the conversation with "I love you." He was loved as well and will be missed.
