William Clifford “Richard” Snyder, 98, passed away in peace on December 11, 2022.

Richard was born on August 12, 1924 to Porter “Doc” and Trixie (Woodard) Snyder. In World War II, Richard enlisted in the U.S. Navy and received an honorable discharge. Subsequent to his service in the U.S. Navy, Richard married Martha Dale E. Jenkins and was blessed with three children: Dudley A.; James Stephen; and Sybil Susan. Richard retired from Republic Steel Corporation and was known by his coworkers for his tireless energy.

Richard lived in Southside, Alabama most of his life and was an active member of Southside Baptist Church in which he was involved in church functions, including Wednesday nights with the children and making them laugh when he participated in games. He loved Alabama Summers, was an avid gardener, and would often be seen working his land to grow produce that he freely shared with everyone in the community. Richard would often recount his childhood memories to every person he came in contact with which served to provide a unique historical perspective of the time period.
